#### 6. Updates from areas of responsibility, other meetings and correspondence

• Park Committee – any updates, including maintenance required following updated ROSPA report and findings, Park Litter.

Quotation received from HAGS for the urgent swing repairs of £1,958.20. Approved subject to checking no cheaper quotes and that work covered all areas flagged up in ROSPA report.

One of the Park committee members to attend our meeting in April to discuss other improvement works required.

Cllr Diamond to consider the possible of a general litter picking group for the Park, teaming up with the village litter picking group.

One of the bins in the Park needs replacing. Cllr Gigg will check the size and inform the Clerk.

- Highways updates
  - o PROW updates
    - Next steps in respect of report on PROWs in South Milford parish No updates vet.
    - Update in respect of Network Rail footpath closure consultation Cllr Grogan circulated a small report on this to the Councillors. Proposed that South Milford Parish Council object with 3 reasons:
      - 1. Lack of safe alternative route
      - 2. Footpath connects to other footpaths leading to other villages (Monk Fryston, Sherburn in Elmet and Hambleton)
      - 3. No risk assessment that substantiate Network Rail's safety concern claims.

The objection was proposed by Cllr Gore, seconded Cllr Gigg and all agreed.

- Funding for Signage and maintenance of paths Cllr Faria Dean proposed better footpath signposts around the Parish. The posts start at £7.50 each. After discussion it was agreed that £400 be put aside for the purchase of signposts and markers. Quotations for these to be sourced for approval at the next meeting. Cllr Grogan to see if there is any funding available for this from NYCC.
- Ideas for circular routes and signage Cllr Faria Dean suggested promoting attendance at formal path training course, with advertising on Facebook – all Cllrs supportive.
- HGVs through South Milford update from Cllr Grogan Waiting for Highways to report back following Cllr Shaw's findings/suggestions.

- Clerk to forward pictures to Gary Lumb of Highways, received from a concerned resident about the state of a wall that runs near the beck on Low Street opposite the Swan.
- Fly tipping and dog fouling any updates Cllr Diamond to update at the next meeting.
- Discussion regarding gritting discuss offer from local resident Cllr Houston tried to contact the resident without success, she will continue trying.
- Communications discuss feedback on newsletter and agree our approach to responding. Agreed that responses will be sent to all residents who contacted the Parish Council following our newsletter (about the dog park or other items) Cllr Gore to arrange.
- Allotments possible next steps c/f next meeting
- CIL funds discussing possible spending c/f next meeting

## 7. Items for discussion including further Actions, Proposals and Votes

- Seek approval for any Park works / maintenance see item 6 re swing repair approval
- Decision and next steps regarding refurbishing benches and litter bins around the Parish discuss quotes No further quotations received except David Shaw. Clerk to contact YLCA to clarify the rules on relatives doing work for the PC.
- Decision and next steps regarding the use of the remaining Section 106 money (and potentially CIL funds as well) with a possible Dog Exercise area in the Quarry off Westfield Lane being one option. The Council received significantly more objections to the dog park idea than supportive messages, with many valid reasons, so will not be going ahead with this. Cllr Gigg agreed to draft wording setting out our response to the consultation about the dog park, which we will share with all residents who wrote to us and also post on our website and Facebook. The council are now actively considering other ideas to use the Section 106 monies, with a sensory (dementia friendly) garden in the area to the east of the MUGA in the Park one option being considered.
- Vacant land off Common Lane Discuss and agree Council actions and any possible expenditure in respect of this Cllr Shaw informed the PC that she had spoken to a Solicitors who are willing to look into potential owners of the land on behalf of the PC. The initial cost, including fees to date, will be approximately £450 plus VAT. Proposed Cllr Faria Dean, seconded Cllr Gigg, all agreed.
- Decision regarding possible clearing work on the footpath from Beech Drive to Westfield Lane (quotation received) After discussion it was agreed that they would not go ahead with the big clean up but would just have yearly tidy up done as in previous years.
