South Milford Parish Council supports the Definitive Map Modification Order (DMMO) application by Mr Antoni Janik to upgrade the footpath 35.59/6/1 into a bridleway and change its route slightly so that it is on Turpin Lane (without deviating into the field to the west of Milford Grange). This decision is evidenced in the minutes of the 19th January 2021 meeting, which are attached.

South Milford Parish Council supports this DMMO application for a number of reasons. Firstly, this DMMO ensures that the link between South Milford and Monk Fryston can be used by cyclists and equestrians, in a route that avoids busy roads such as Lumby Lane. Secondly, it contributes to a circular route linking South Milford, Lumby and Monk Fryston, via pavements and quiet roads. Thirdly, having the route over Turpin Lane, which has a relatively good surface, would allow families with buggies to use this route, while the segment over the field can be difficult to use when the weather has been poor.
