  - o update from Cllr Shaw regarding proposed sensory garden (to the East of the MUGA) Cllr Shaw updated the PC on this. 3 quotes have been received which are between £25-£30k. Cllr Shaw is applying for grants to cover.
  - update on grants for replacing adventure trial equipment.
    Tom on the Parks Committee is looking into grants.
- Highways updates
  - o PROW updates, including:

Minor proposed diversion of the Old Quarry Lane - Grove Crescent footpath – This was discussed and agreed. Access from Old Quarry Lane to the start of the new footpath needs to be made safe. Proposed Cllr Gigg seconded Cllr Gore.

Any updates re London Road status – nothing

- Request for double yellow lines on the corner of High Street and Woodlands Lane.
  Clerk to write to the resident. If yellow lines are put here, unfortunately it will just move the problem elsewhere in the village. Note that anyone can apply on the NYCC online site.

  - Vacant land off Common Lane Cllr Shaw provided brief update.
  - Football club changing rooms project hoping to instal changing rooms end July.
  - South Milford Community Support group still exists but little ongoing work.

## 6. Items for discussion including further Actions, Proposals and Votes

- Seek approval for any urgent Park works / maintenance **none**
- Update on current financial situation. Around £35k of funds available, with £12k promised / set-aside for the flood defence works.
- Possible uses of the remaining Section 106 money (and potentially CIL funds as well)
  - o main option being considered is the creation of a sensory (dementia friendly) garden in the area to the east of the MUGA in the Park **update earlier**.
  - development of the Old Quarry area seats, paths and the road delineated with a low fence along the roadside The council are supportive of this and Cllr Shaw to ask
    S & J Landscapes for ideas and report back.
- Cutting of the grass verges around the village (including Sand Lane and the Old Quarry) and surrounding roads (such as Whitecote Lane) Clerk to Contact NYCC about Whitecotes and the A63. Cllr Gore to email Kellingley's to seek cuts of a few unkept verges within the village.
- Weed treatment in gutters and pavement edges, and the path from Westfield Lane to Beech Drive. Cllr Shaw to sort with Kellingley's. Beech Drive will be left till later in the year as passable and no hazards at present.
- Speeding around the parish any actions we could take? Clerk to look into the speed light up signs and report back.
- SDC Chairman's charities request for donations The council considered this and agreed to not provide a donation, noting there were no charities local to our parish.
