

Updates from South Milford Parish Council

- **Newsletter** – If it hasn't already, watch out for a Parish Council Newsletter dropping through your letter box. Please find time to read it as it provides useful updates on the main activities of the council during the past year.
- **Yellow lines (Sand Lane / Low Street)** – We have lobbied for double yellow lines to stop the parking at the junction of Sand Lane and Low Street, which has led to serious safety concerns. NYCC has agreed to this and we are currently waiting for this work to be carried out.
- **Yellow lines (Milford Road)** – Following the introduction of parking charges at the train station (which we lobbied against), as expected some commuters had started to park on Milford Road. In response to this, NYCC introduced a prohibition order covering waiting, loading and parking on Milford Road for an experimental period of up to 18 months. NYCC have stated that the reasons for making this order were to avoid danger to persons and traffic and to facilitate better passage of traffic. Objections to the indefinite continuation of the order should be made to NYCC by emailing area7.selby@northyorks.gov.uk before 29 January 2019.
Note that NYCC did not consult with the Parish Council (or the wider community) regarding the introduction of these yellow lines and we have voiced our disapproval regarding this lack of consultation on a major highways issue in the village.
